Writing	Practice spelling words with digraphs using the correct formation for each letter	
	Practice the correct letter formation for the sounds learnt in phonics	
Maths	Write and order numbers 0 to 9 correctly	
	Look out for or make sets of objects with up to 9 items (see task below too)	
Extra Challenge	We will be looking at Traditional Tales after half-term. Find a 'Fairy Tale' you love	
	and draw a picture of your favourite character – we will have a circle time to share
