These are the tasks that you should aim to complete each week for your homework this half term.

These will go out on a Friday and should be returned the next Wednesday, latest, as that's when we will have our spellings check.

23.2.24	Music – Use your knowledge of ballads to create a short song, this could have a repeating chorus and multiple verses, think about your theme.
1.3.24	Geography – What features are in our settlement? Create a small map of your local area in an aerial view (from above) using symbols for common features. (I'd recommend Google Maps/Earth to help!)
8.3.24	Reading – Write a book review of a book you've read recently. This can be about fiction or non-fiction. Use your 'Explain' skill to show your perspective!
15.3.24	Maths – Demonstrate your knowledge of equivalent fractions in at least 2 different ways (you could use shapes, amounts or numbers), using pictures will help you demonstrate this!
22.3.24	Science – Design and create your own shadow puppets! Record what you made and how you made it in your homework book (photos encouraged, if possible)!
27.3.24 (Weds)	English – During your break, record a recount (or diary entry) of either a day or several days to explain and summarise what you have experienced. It does not need to be a "special" day, but don't forget to include how you were feeling.
