Parents evening appointments

Teachers will be liaising with parents regarding the time slot they require for their Teams parents meeting next week. We are prioritising siblings and club users then the appointment times will be open to the general school community. Should you wish to email the school with your preferred time, we can take these into account and we endeavour to give parents the date and time as close as possible to the one requested.

These parents meetings are virtual and will be a maximum of 10 minutes. The meetings are to discuss how well your child has settled into their class, their learning behaviours and learning attitude and friendships. If there are matters you wish to discuss, which will require more time to discuss, another meeting will need to be made with the relevant staff in attendance. Written notes will be made, during the meeting, as a record of the conversation. You will receive a target sheet regarding your child's progress and advice as to what you can do at home to support them.

Parking

We have recently experienced issues with parent parking and parents turning in the road outside of the school. This is not only dangerous for other road users, it is also hazardous to pedestrians. Please can parents driving their children to school be mindful of other road users and children walking to school. Please be respectful of our neighbours' drive way access and avoid parking on the grass verges which are becoming churned up, due to the water-logged grass.

With the weather due to change soon. **Please ensure that your child has a pair of named wellies that can be kept in school**. Without them, children won't be able to participate in outdoor activities, in wet weather. When the children choose to work outside, it is essential that they have a complete change of clothing to keep them comfortable, if they get wet or muddy. Please ensure all kit and spares are named, so we can reunite errant clothing with their owners, easily. Practicing dressing and undressing would be a great way for the children to gain independence and we appreciate the support from home in this area.
