

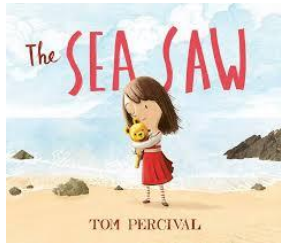
**Forest School is on Friday mornings for Squirrel Class.**

**PE is now on THURSDAY, wear school outdoor PE kit including a jumper, trainers, sunhat & suncream.**

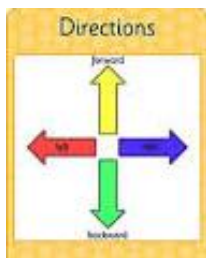
## Language and Literacy

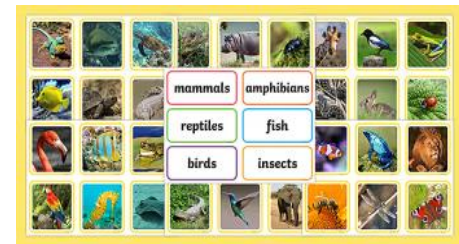
## Maths

Year 1 have been learning about Position and Direction. There has been lots of moving around and placing/moving of objects in practical tasks this week as they explored making Full Turns, Half-Turns, Quarter-Turns and then turning and moving Left and Right. They also used Ordinal Numbers (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> etc) to give instructions for building block models to each other. Year 2 did a brilliant job in completing their Maths SATS papers – really great endurance!



## Science

We are starting a topic on Animals. Looking at a range of animals, we revised their features and the similarities and differences between them. Then using the main classification groups of animals, we talked about then recorded what common characteristics mean animals belong together and what differences there can be within a larger group.



## History

We have begun a new unit of learning on Personal History on the theme of Holiday in the Past. We started by sharing our own memories of a memorable holiday. Then we looked at some photographs of families on holidays Now and in the 1990s, 1970s and 1950s to look for what was similar and different about where people went, how they travelled, what accommodation they had and what they did. There is some home learning to support this topic.
