

English	This half term in English we will be studying Grimm Tales for the Old and Young. Through the sequence of learning, children will analyse the language, characterisation and common story structure across many of the tales. Using the story of Cinderella, they will make comparisons between many versions of the same story and analyse the extent to which these stories can be classified as 'fairy tales'. Children will eventually work towards creating their own Grimm tale, planning for a balance of dialogue and narrative and using devices to advance the action quickly. There will be an opportunity for children to create books of their own writing.
Maths	This half term we will be learning about position and direction, statistics and converting units.
Geography	Our unit in Geography is titled 'Can I carry out an independent fieldwork enquiry?' The children will be identifying issues in the local area and then collecting evidence before presenting and analysing the data they have collected.
Science	Our science learning is based around the topic of the human timeline – looking at stages of growth and changes that occur (this links to our RSE and PSHE)
DT	In DT we will be creating pop-up books. We will be planning the book, following the brief, looking at mechanisms that can be used to make a pop up book and then evaluating our books.
RE	During our RE lessons we will be answering the big question of 'How can we care for the world and each other?'
French	In our MFL lessons we will be covering a unit titled 'French sport and the Olympics' where we will be learning to express opinions about sports; writing about sports that they could play and conjugating the verb aller – to go.
Music	Our music lessons will consist of learning the songs for our summer production, as well as working on composition skills.
PE	In PE lessons the learning will continue to be provided by Sports 4All and will focus on teambuilding skills as well as understanding the techniques and rules of different sports. As well as this we will be carrying on with swimming lessons.
