Many tasks will allow exploration of other media and resources. Please ask if you're uncertain of how to complete or record these tasks.

Please also remember to:

- Practice your spellings (which will be stuck in weekly) in whichever way you please. For example, writing them in a sentence, making them into a word-search, 'look-cover-write-check', mnemonics, songs, etc.
- Reading and recording this in your record, at least four times a week. Let's fill in our VIPERS!
- Complete at least 15 minutes of Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) games across the week.
- Go on to SPAG.com to complete a task of your choice, set in line with learning.

Your homework book will be given out on Friday, after explaining your new tasks and spellings for the week. These should be returned in the morning on the next Wednesday, to inform our spellings check and prepare for the next week's learning.

Reading records should be brought in (in bags) each day, these will be marked throughout the week and give us opportunities for reading in class.

Vocabulary , Infer , Predict , Retrieve , Summarise ... We've already had some people earn scales in class! 😊
18.9.26	We are learning more about Hinduism during our RE lessons! Why do you think that Hindu's might also like our school vision , " <i>Shining brightly in all we do</i> "? <u>Discuss</u> and <u>research</u> at home- <u>record</u> your thoughts however you think's best!
25.9.26	Our Science learning has been all about Movement and Nutrition ! Draw yourself a delicious plate full of food , showing a balanced diet . Label the food groups (<i>nutrients, minerals, vitamins</i>) that you've included, to show it is balanced!
